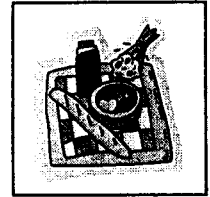


# PHILADELPHIA AREA GROUP PSYCHOTHERAPY SOCIETY

### Directions to 35 Violet Lane (610-622-4931)

#### From Main Line/Northwestern parts:

- Take City Line Ave. (Rt. 1) to the Lansdowne Ave./Darby Rd. intersection (the first light after crossing Westchester Pike/Route 3). (If coming from the western Main Line, you could take Darby Rd. through Havertown, which becomes Lansdowne Ave. after crossing City Line Ave.)
- Take a left onto Lansdowne Ave. and proceed through Drexel Hill (passing Upper Darby High School, Delaware County Memorial Hospital, Monsignor Bonner/Archbishop Prendergast High Schools—all on your left). When you cross the trolley tracks at Garrett Rd. you will enter Lansdowne. Stay on Lansdowne Ave. through Lansdowne, going through the center of town, crossing Baltimore Pike, over the railroad bridge.
- Violet Ln. is the third street on the right after crossing Baltimore Pike. It is a small gravel lane, approx. 100 yards long, and #35 is the last house on the lane. **Because parking is tight on Violet, please park on Lansdowne Ave. and walk down the lane.**

#### From Media and the Blue Route (I-476):

- Take Baltimore Pike east from Media and the Blue Route. Stay on Baltimore Pike through Springfield, Clifton Heights (the road narrows to two lanes), and into Lansdowne.
- Turn right at Lansdowne Ave.; Violet Lane is the third street on the right after turning onto Baltimore Pike. See parking information above.

#### From Center City:

- Take Walnut St. west until it dead-ends at 63<sup>rd</sup> St. (Cobbs Creek Parkway).
- Turn left onto 63<sup>rd</sup> St. and go to the first light, which is Marshall Rd. Take a right turn onto Marshall Rd., and follow Marshall Rd. through Upper Darby. Marshall Rd. will divide, splitting to the right as you enter Lansdowne (just past West Lumber). Stay on Marshall as it splits until you get to the first light. This light is at the intersection with Lansdowne Ave.
- Turn left onto Lansdowne Ave. and take Lansdowne through the intersection of Baltimore Pike, following the directions above.
